Rules for payment of bounties

Member rate: \$150 bounty per coyote for coyotes harvested in Llano County

Nonmember rate: \$50 bounty per coyote harvested in Llano County

Adjoining County Member rate: \$50 per coyote harvested outside Llano County with an annual limit of \$2000 in bounties (bounty paid by membership dues, no county monies)

Non members outside of Llano County: No bounty to be paid for any coyotes

Prior to \$2000 in total bounties for the year being paid, the bounty recipient will furnish a completed W-9 form along with the payment request. No payments over \$2000 will be made until the W-9 form is received by the HCLRA. If a W-9 form has been furnished previously, another form will not be required. W-9 forms are available on <https://www.irs.gov>

In case of any questionable situation the HCLRA board will be the deciding authority and the association's decision will be final. The association reserves the right to decline any request for a bounty to be paid.

Any bounty checks that are not cleared within 90 days of issuance will be presented to the HCLRA board of directors. The directors have the right to declare the checks void and the proceeds returned to the account from which they were issued. The original recipient of the check will receive a notice giving them credit for a donation to the association.
